A great friend, fellow Rotarian and Coordinator of the ARH Ride to Conference, Rob Henry, passed away last week after a short battle with cancer. We can only echo the words from our friends at Australian Rotary Health...

"It is with a heavy heart that we announce the passing of PP Rob Henry, who will always be remembered for his contribution and dedication to Australian Rotary Health.



Rob was a member of the Rotary Club of Boronia in District 9810 and became the driving force behind the 'Ride for Research Dollars', an annual charity bike ride to the 9810 District Conference.

Over 30 years, the event has raised over \$1 million dollars for health research projects through Australian Rotary Health, and this was in part due to Rob's passion and leadership.

In 2012, Rob was awarded the Australian Rotary Health Medal to recognise his continuous support for our cause, including not only the district bike rides, but for providing advice in the planning and execution of the Great Australian Bike Ride event around Australia in 2009.

In addition to this, Rob and his wife Valerie were praised for their beautiful home

garden, which they opened up to the public for exhibition. The proceeds from this were also donated to Australian Rotary Health.
