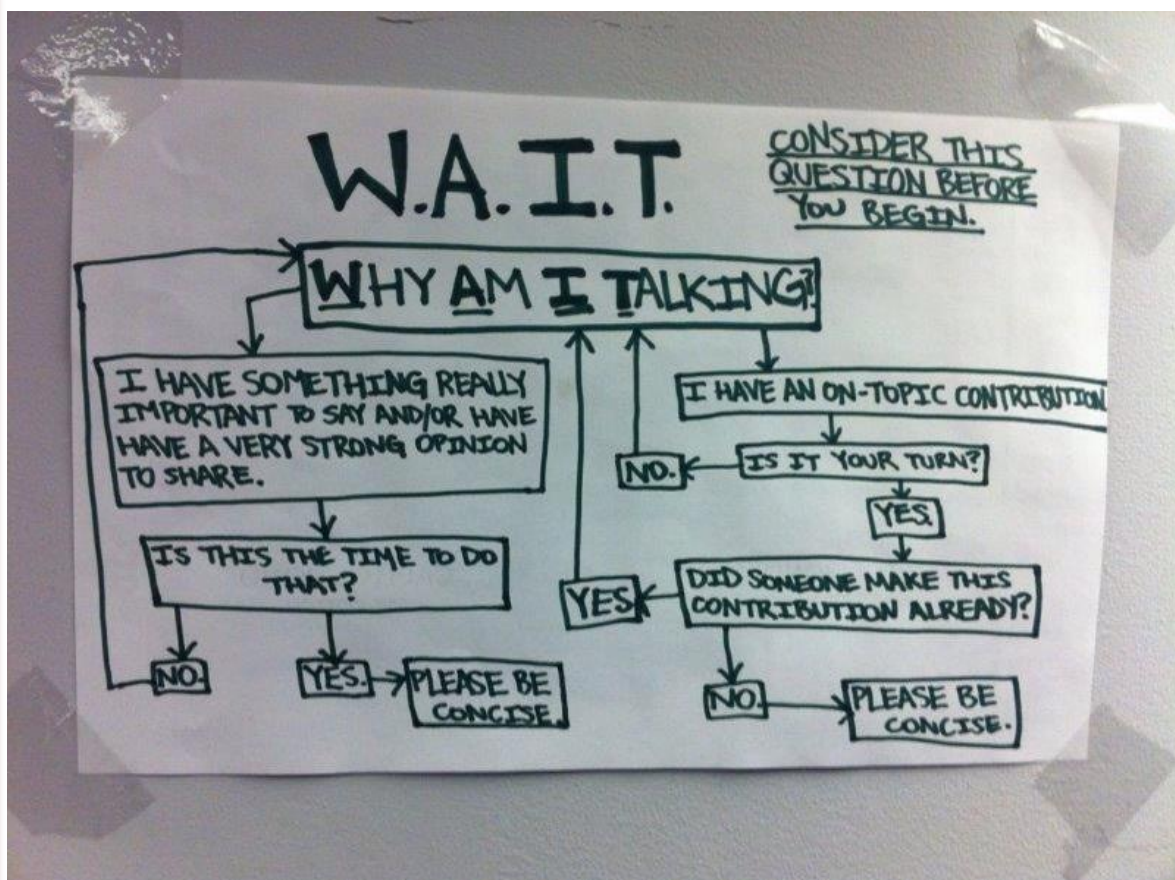
THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life.

In six months, 120kgs of coins and notes sent to UNICEF were valued by them at **\$4,700.64**.



Please help us continue for ROMAC – it won't cost you one cent!

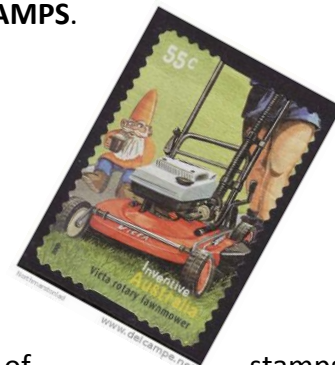
