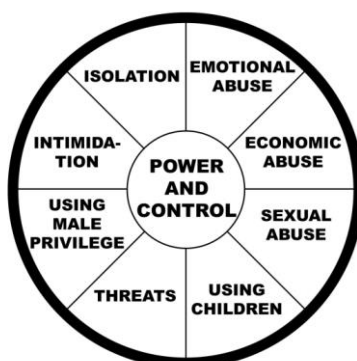
This Week

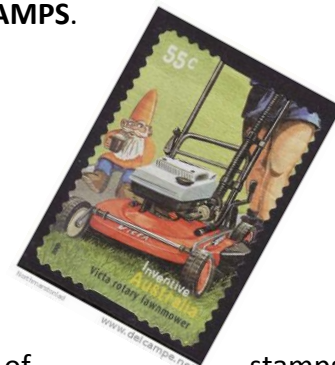

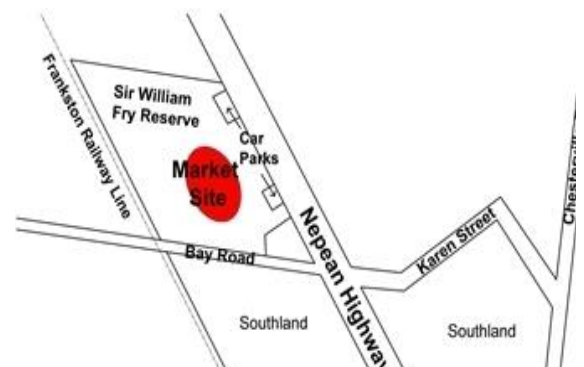
