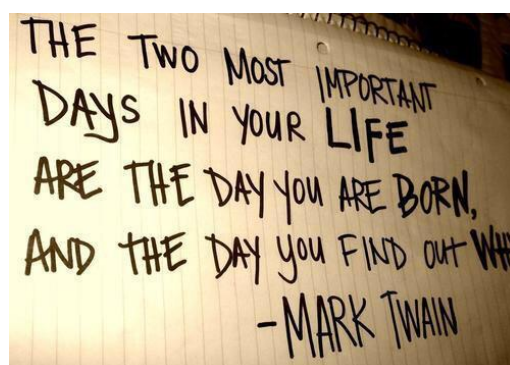
THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life.

Proposed New Member



CHELSEA ROTARY KIVA account up and running

Yes, it's a red letter day. After some years in the planning, and acceptance by our Board of a fifteen page business case (we are happy to provide a copy to other Rotary Clubs), Chelsea Rotary has started a KIVA portfolio of loans (totalling AUS\$1000) to fund overseas projects to help people mainly in the areas of food, hygiene, water supply, sanitation and education. The loans will be repaid within approximately 12 months, allowing the funds to be re-used to help other worthwhile causes. We aim to present information on our portfolio and how KIVA works at a meeting in the near future.

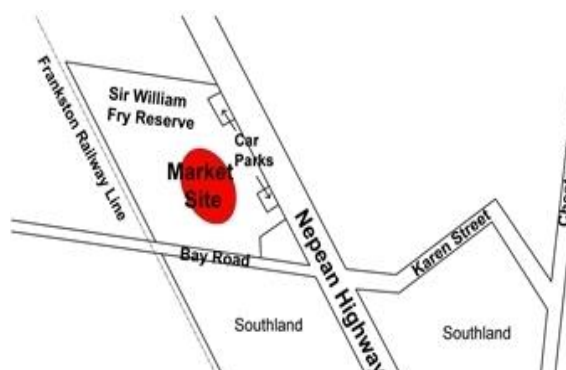

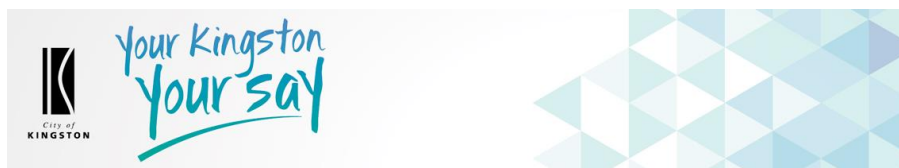
