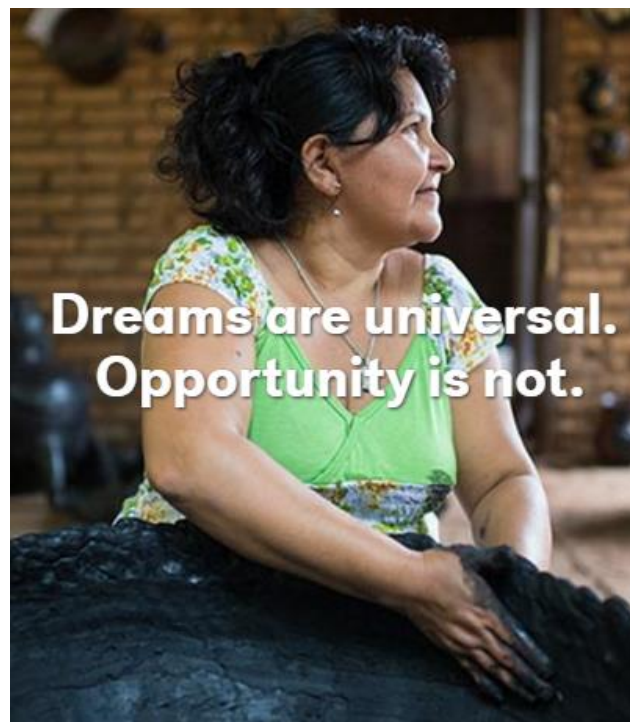
THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life.

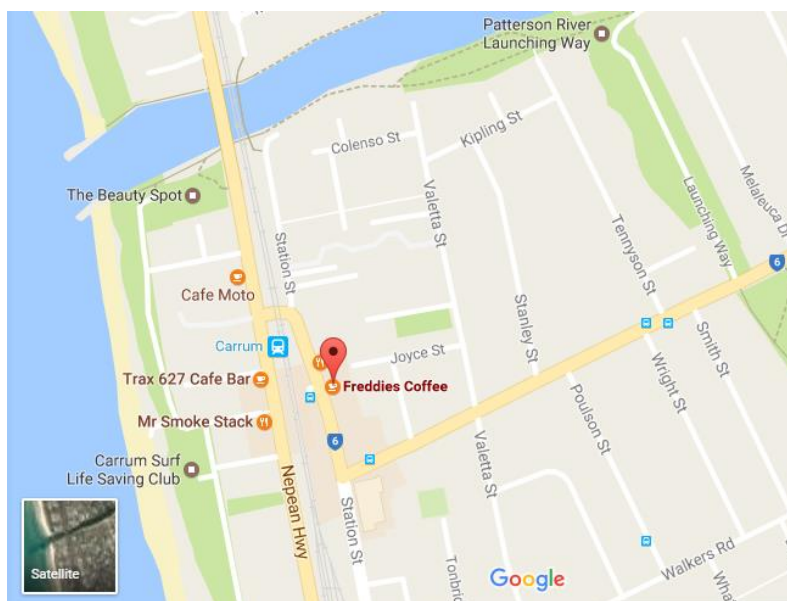

CHELSEA ROTARY KIVA PORTFOLIO – more details

We have loaned funds to support eight projects:

- Five loans over 8 months for providing water filters for five groups in Cambodia (mainly family groups) ensuring 19 people have fresh drinking water each day.
- Loan over 15 months for a 46 year old wife and mother of six children who runs a general store kiosk in Timor Leste, which has enabled her to become independent. She hopes to buy a fridge one day to keep drinks cold.
- Loan over 14 months to help a mother of four children in El Salvador to buy chickens and animal feed and use part of the profit to pay for her children's education. She has been in business seven years and has already paid back two Kiva loans.
- Loan over 21 months for tools for a husband and father of one in Palestine who fixes stoves. Average annual income in Palestine is US\$4900 / yr.

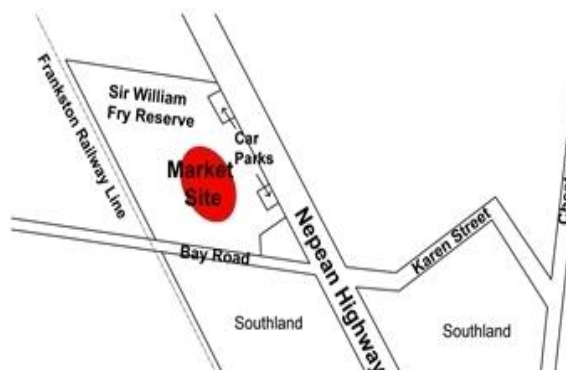

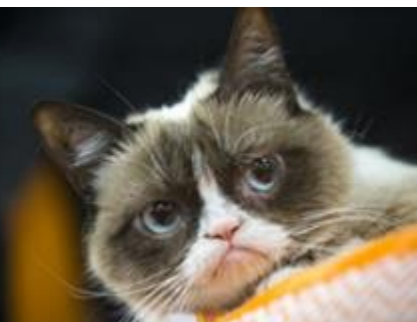

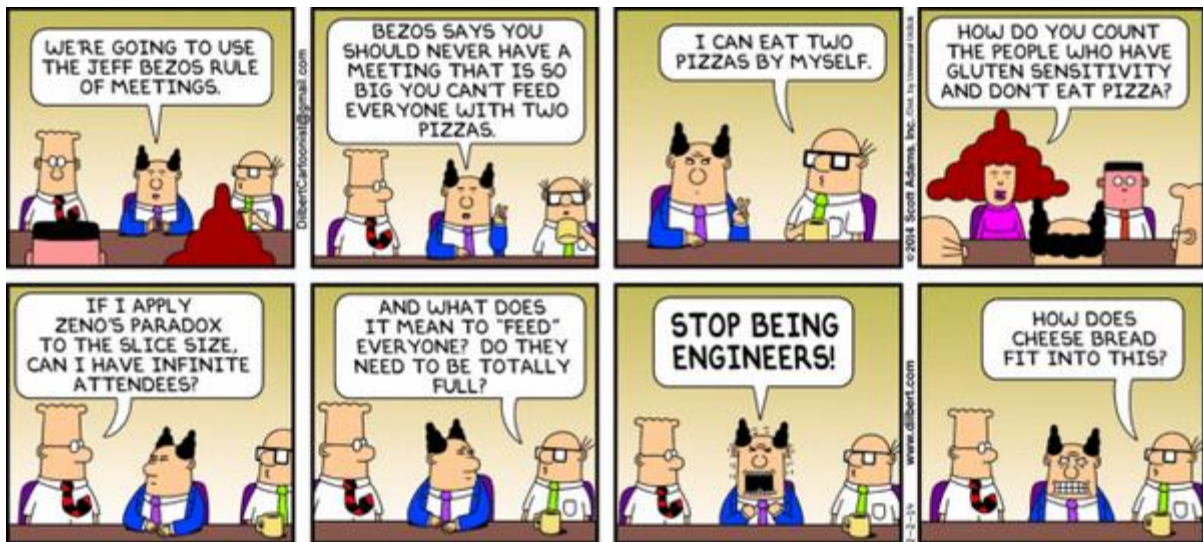
