FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service.

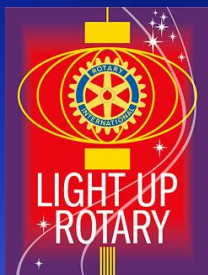
