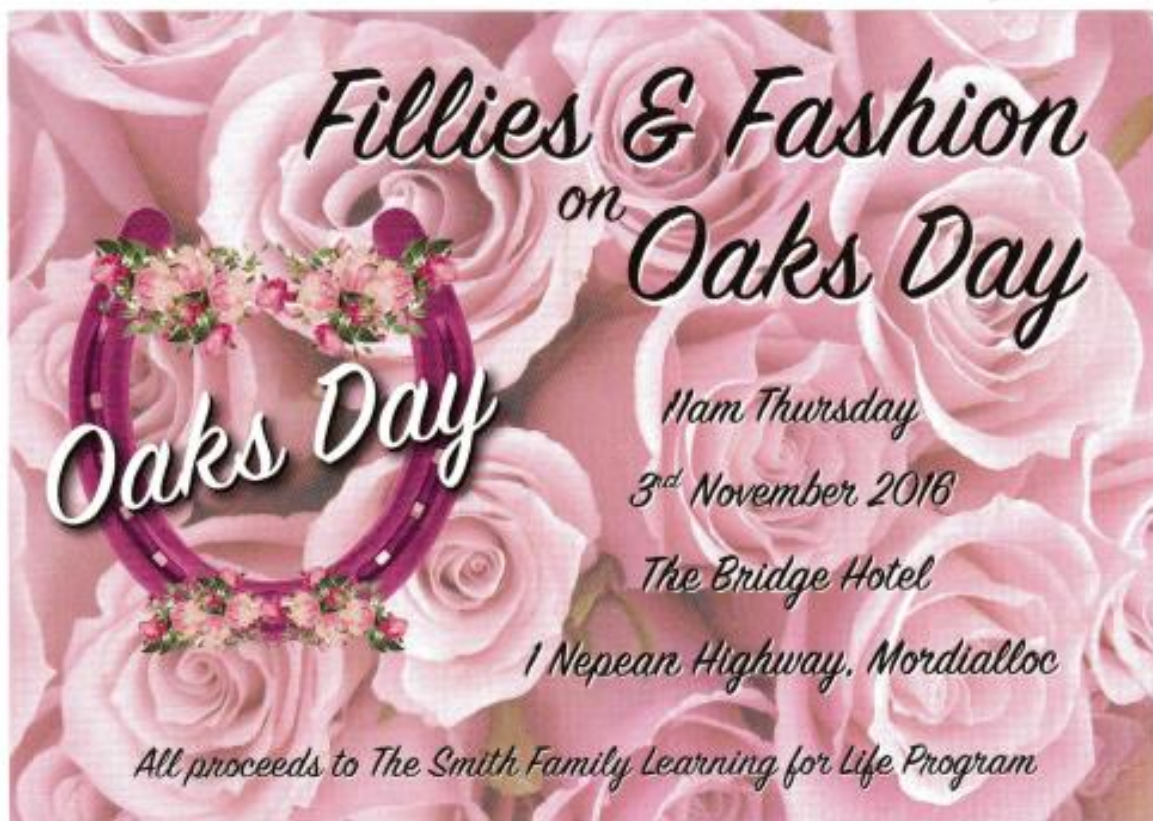

In the last six months, 120kgs of coins and notes sent to UNICEF were valued by them at **\$4,700.64**.

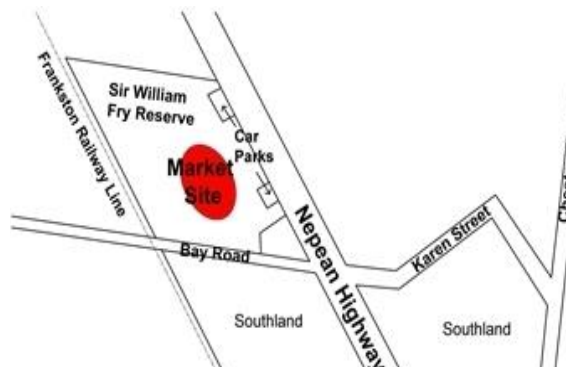
